## What is an AAPI Tenants' Rights Awareness Campaign?

In partnership with the Office of the Tenant Advocate, OAPIA is launching an educational campaign aimed to increase Asian American and Pacific Islanders' understanding of their rights as tenants.

### Goals of the Campaign

- 1) Raising awareness of tenants' rights through various outreach efforts
- 2) Figuring out the largest housing concerns of the AAPI community by conducting a housing needs assessment survey
- 3) Recommending solutions to AAPI LEP/NEP residents on how to resolve various housing issues

### Who can it benefit?

AAPI residents living in the District of Columbia, regardless of legal U.S. citizenship, local landlords, and community members.

### How can you contribute?

District government agencies and community based organizations can help spread awareness by publicizing it through their newsletters, distributing campaign materials to their constituents, and directing interested individuals to OAPIA.
