

PRISON PROBLEMS DISASTER RESPONSE

Background:

According to a US Department of Justice report published in 2006, over 7.2 million people were at that time in prison, on probation, or on parole. That means roughly 1 in every 32 Americans are held by the justice system. With prisons located throughout the U.S., citizens that live or work by correctional facilities should stay alert of any issues such as notified escapes that may arise.

If you Work in the Vicinity of a Correctional Facility and are Notified of an Escape:

- Stay vigilant.
- Keep your doors and windows locked at home.
- Do not open your door for strangers.
- Report any suspicious behavior or person in your neighborhood.
DO NOT approach anyone suspected of escaping—call 9-1-1 immediately.
