

SPECIAL EVENTS, DEMONSTRATIONS AND CIVIL DISRUPTIONS DISASTER RESPONSE

Background:

As the nation's capital, the District is frequently the scene of special events and demonstrations, some of which bring the possibility of civil disruptions. Such events are monitored closely by emergency management and law enforcement officials, and the public is notified through District alert systems (Alert DC, you can sign up online at <https://textalert.ema.dc.gov>) and websites to take proper precaution with traffic and parking enforcement.

In the Event of a Special Event, Demonstration or Civil Disruption:

- Avoid the area where the event, demonstration or disruption is occurring.
- Obey posted "No Parking" signs.
- Be vigilant of surroundings.
- Report any suspicious behavior.
