### A Message from the Director

Dear Community Members,

Since the last fiscal year, our agency has been focusing on creating new cultural sensitivity training for other DC agencies. We have worked with the Metropolitan Police Department (MPD) and DC Public School (DCPS) to create cultural competency training videos that entail information about the AAPI communities in DC and their different sets of challenges. Both training also include our suggestions and resources on how to better serve and interact with the AAPIs. MPD has already started to use this training video as part of their training course, and all MPD members including approximately 3,500 police officers and 500 civilian staff have watched the



video. DCPS will also incorporate our cultural training material into their training webinar series for teachers and school staff.

We are planning to build on these introductory training and keep working with these agencies to develop in-depth cultural sensitivity training in the near future.

In our growing multicultural society, cultural competency is important for all. With increased cross-cultural sensitivity, we all have a better ability to understand our differences and build trusting relationships. We will continue our efforts to work with other DC agencies to address our constituents' needs and enhance cultural competence.
