Dear Community Members,

Over 89% of the dry cleaners in the District are owned by Asian and Pacific Islanders, which is why the Mayor's Office on Asian and Pacific Islander Affairs (MOAPIA) and the Department of Consumer and Regulatory Affairs (DCRA) work closely together to ensure that these business owners stay up-to-date with regulations and have access to government services and resources.

This Thursday, **November 30th from 12:00 - 2:00 pm**, MOAPIA and DCRA will host a free educational program for all licensed dry cleaners at 1100 4th Street SW.

The purpose of the DC Dry Cleaner Community Compliance Training is to:

- Educate all boiler operated dry cleaners on how to become and remain compliant with District regulations and code requirements.
- Offer resources for test preparation and assist with onsite licensing renewals.
- Review and reinforce the importance of boiler operation safety and DCRA's role in enforcing regulations for a safer DC.

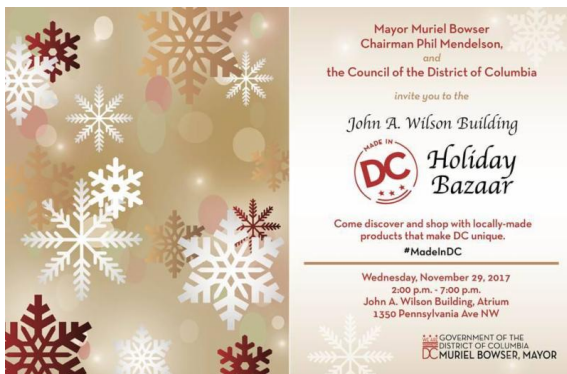
MOAPIA Outreach
